

Project background

- Prior to the arrival of Coventry University (CU Scarborough) the Borough of Scarborough has been identified by HEFCE as a Higher Education cold spot.
- Scarborough is one of just ten Government identified "Opportunity Areas", is the lowest paid Borough in the Country and is isolated with 180 degrees of sea running to the east.
- Scarborough has an ageing population (higher than other regions).

Project funding




CU Scarborough (part of the Coventry University Group) successfully secured £247,600 over a 3-year period from the Office for Students (OfS).




